Clan McAlister of America

The primary mission of the Clan McAlister of America is to research our McAlister ancestry and culture, and then to share and preserve this information. So far we have established 330 significant McAlister family lines primarily in North America -- many of them going back to the original immigrants from Scotland or Ireland. We now have over 100,000 McAlister descendants in our family database, which we use to link family lines together. By sharing information, everyone has benefitted. There are several ways you can send your information so we can find out which McAlister family you belong to.

Family histories, Family Group Sheets, and other printed materials. Please send us copies of your family information so we can include them in our Genealogy Library. All material will be reviewed and entered into the database if it is information we do not already have.

Computer users. If you have your family history in a computer genealogy program or online (like Ancestry.com), we can easily add your data to our family database. The best way to do this is for you to send us a GEDCOM file by e-mail. If you need help or more detailed instructions, just ask. It is easy to do.
